Dear Parents, Guardians and **Men** of the Instrumental Music Department,

Please read this letter in its entirety as there is important information about proper concert attire.

The Men's dress code for all concerts includes: a tuxedo, bow tie, white tuxedo shirt, **solid** black socks, and black shoes. Students are responsible for being properly attired. NFHS provides the loan of a 2-piece tuxedo and bow tie for the school year. The Men are asked to provide their own tuxedo shirt (pleated with wing collar), black socks and shoes. **A new tuxedo shirt can be ordered for \$15.00.** The Fitting Day volunteers will measure your student during a Uniform Fitting Night. We also have some gently used, dry-cleaned shirts (Sizes vary) for purchase at the Fitting Nights for \$7.00. **Professional alterations will be provided for a \$10 Fee.**

Please print and complete the Uniform Loan Contract and attach payment for fees. Check(s) payable to: NFHS Band and Orchestra Boosters. **Make sure the contract is signed by both a parent/guardian and the student.** Please bring both, the completed and signed contract and the payment to the Uniform Fitting Night. **NO UNIFORM will be issued until a completed signed contract and deposit are RECEIVED, and any outstanding fines have been paid.** There will be a charge for lost or missing items, replacement items (ties, vests, shirts, etc.) and/or items returned in poor condition (torn, heavily soiled, etc., other than normal wear and tear).
