Please read this ENTIRE letter for important information about concert attire.

**Please PRINT AND SIGN the Uniform Contract both parent-guardian and student.

Bring the signed copy of the Uniform Loan Contract and payment to one of the Uniform Fitting Days listed below.*

A **Concert Dress Uniform** is provided by North Farmington High School Music Department for use during all performances unless otherwise indicated. Students may choose to add their own optional - ALL black shrug. Concert Dresses are professionally dry cleaned and the **cleaning fee of \$20** is collected at the Fitting Evenings. **Professional alterations are available for a \$10 Fee.**

The all black outfit for performances should meet the following criteria:

*School Provided Concert Uniform Dress

*Optional Addition: All Black plain shrug to wear with school provided dress

Hosiery - Plain Dark hose or knee highs

Shoes - Black, low heeled or flats; no flip flops (Stairs)

Jewelry, hair ties and make-up - modest and professional

Conservative All Black dress, skirt or dress slacks with black top- *with prior approval

Concert Uniforms will be fitted and distributed on:
