In addition, here are answers to frequently asked questions:

What does the trip cost?

The cost for students or chaperones, staying in quad hotel rooms, is \$1629 inclusive. The cost for chaperones, staying in double hotel rooms, \$1801. See full details on the Payment information page. The cost of airfare could cause the total price to go down or up slightly if ticket costs are below or above our current estimate.

Which students are eligible to participate?

Band, Percussion, and Orchestra students of Ms. Babcock or Mr. Kennedy at NFHS are eligible. Choir students of Mr. Debandt will also be participating, under a separate tour number to accommodate different performance activities.

When can we register?

Registration is open now. We have initially booked 2 coaches with 110 seats. (Busses are used while in Orlando). We can only exceed 110 total if we can fill a third 56 passenger coach. Until that point, everyone beyond the initial maximum will be wait-listed. If the 3rd coach is not filled, refunds will be given to all who cannot be accommodated.

What is trip insurance?

Please note that without trip insurance, all money paid towards the trip is non-refundable after the second payment. Trip insurance information will be distributed well before the refund cutoff date. We HIGHLY recommend purchasing trip insurance for each person registered.

What are fundraising options?

The boosters have 2 fundraisers – the wreath/pointsettia sale and the pie sale – for which all proceeds will be credited to the student accounts. We are looking into additional booster fundraisers. There are many other private fundraising options that students can use – gofundme, etc.

If you do not have access to a computer, you may mail in your credit card information and we will process it for you. **There is a \$15 processing transaction fee for payments called into our office.**

Personal check payments will not be accepted within 50 days (03/25/20) of departure. Only cashier's checks, money orders, or credit cards will be accepted after that date for overdue payments. **Participants not paid in full 50 days (03/25/20) prior to departure will be subject to cancellation from the trip.** **NOTE: All payments are non-refundable and non-transferable after 10/15/19.** The Student Deluxe Plan's Trip Cancellation coverage only applies to the portion of the trip you have paid.

Your Director will have access to all participants' balance due amounts. You will not receive a receipt for your individual payments unless paying by credit card. **The final balance will be given by the Director in charge or by email notice from ETI.**

If the **Entire Trip** is cancelled by the Director **prior to 50 days of departure (03/25/20)**, trip participants will receive a refund of monies paid less a 3.5% processing fee *and* less any non-refundable payments made on the trip's behalf. Travel Protection may not apply to **Entire Trip** cancellation by the Director, unless the trip is cancelled for a reason covered by the plan.

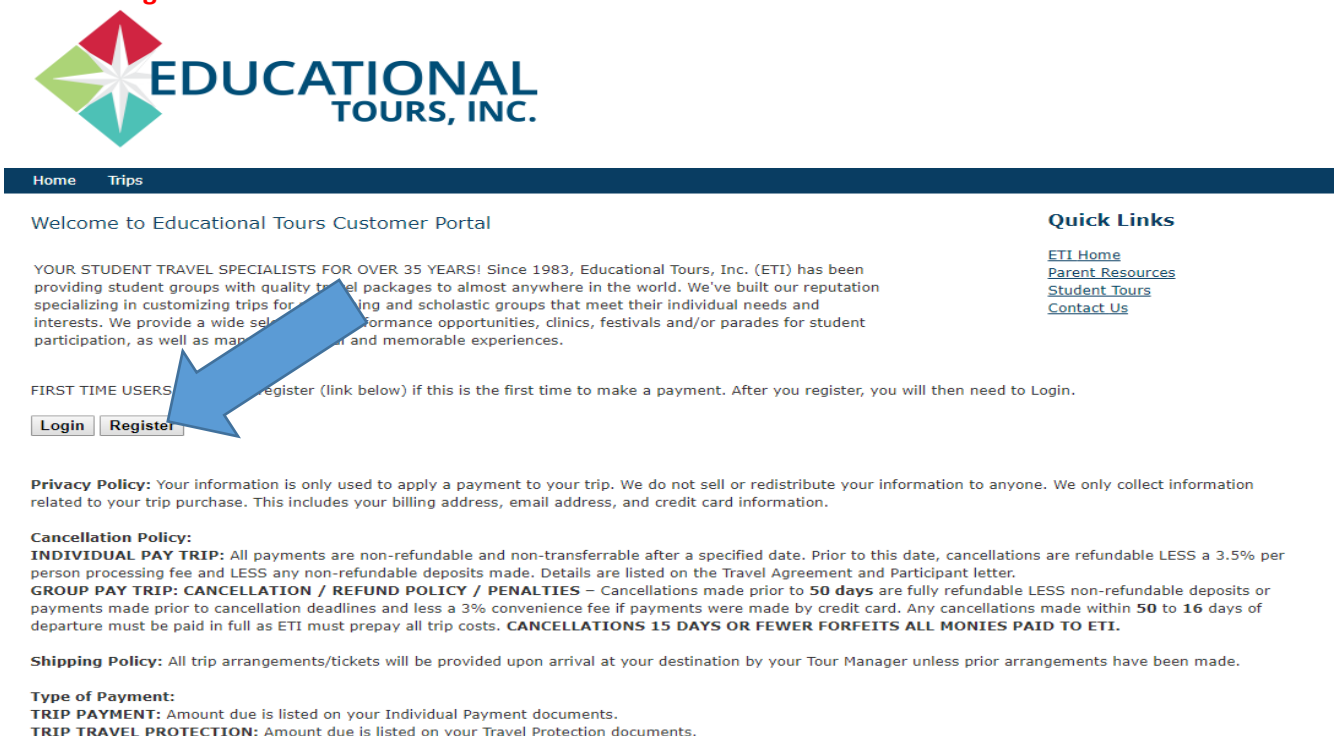
Payment Portal Page Instructions for Payments for "Travel Protection or Trip Payments"

TRIP NAME: North Farmington High School Instrumental Music

1. At www.tours-eti.com, click on **REGISTER/LOGIN**.



2. Click on "Register".



01. Register yourself with your billing address for your Visa, MasterCard, or American Express, email and password. Save. ***This is the billing address for the card & the email receipt. If this does not match your issuing bank address your payment will not process.**
02. Log in using your email & your password that you just created.
03. Add your Trip Number (format example: **20-03065**) to add your trip. You will then see the number of the trip and the name of the trip.
04. Add as many participants as you are paying for. At the end of each participants name you will see a “pay” button. Click this. The next screen will be where you fill in the amount of the trip payment. *Please note that if you enter your name only with no payment you will be put on the “Waiting List”. Making a scheduled payment amount will enroll your name on the Official Trip Roster.* You will need to refresh the screen after making the first payment to change from “Waiting List” to “Traveling”.
(Refresh by either changing to a different screen and then go back to this screen to update it or use the F5 button at the top of your keyboard to refresh.)
05. Fill in the amount of your travel protection payment in the “Travel Protection Amount” field. If travel protection has already been purchased or provided on your behalf, leave 0.00 in the field. Fill in the amount of your trip payment in the “Trip Payment” field.
06. Enter your Visa, MasterCard or American Express number, expiration date and the 3 or 4-digit security number (last number on the backside of your card). Click “**Submit**”. You will see a green “Thank you” and receive an email confirmation for that purchase. *If you see a “**Sorry, your payment cannot be processed**” notice, it is either due to a typing error or the issuing card company rejecting it. It is not ETI or the website determining the rejection. Please retype and submit again to see if you had typing errors or check with your issuing card company to resolve the problem. A confirmation email will state this too for reference. (Refer to #01 above.)*
07. Log out until next time when you will log in with your email & password. If you have forgotten your password the link to recover that is in the lower left-hand corner of the “Log in” Screen. You will receive an email with a link to reset your password. For your security ETI does not have access to your password.
08. REMEMBER, all payments are non-refundable and non-transferable after **10/15/19**.
